

A27 Arundel bypass

In line with the Government's 2015 Road Investment Strategy, Highways England has committed to replacing the existing single carriageway road with a dual carriageway bypass, linking together the two existing dual carriageway sections. The options being presented aim to improve traffic flow, journey times, safety and accessibility, boost local economic growth and minimise the impact on the environment.
