JUNE 2010

RAINFALL

SUMMARY for JUNE 2010

For most of the month, rain-bearing Atlantic weather systems were absent and pressure was relatively high. This meant that June saw plenty of dry, sunny weather. June saw below-average rainfall across almost the whole UK, with less than 50% of normal in many areas including much of Scotland, south Wales, north-west England and southern England.

Bognor Regis was dry and fine throughout the month with the exception of a deluge of rain on the 11th. Records for the average amount of sunshine for the month of June were exceeded by approx. 80 mms. The rainfall was 7.48 mm below the monthly average of 50.18mm.

The mean maximum temperature of 20.0 °C was slightly higher than the seasonal average of 18.04°C and the mean minimum of 11.6°C was also just above the average mean temperature of 11.31°C
