- 2. Supports the addition of the 4th Screen to the Picturedrome on the basis decided by the Town Council on 4th March 2015, funded through extra rent and surplus available to the Bognor Regis Pier Company owned by the Council;
- Rejects any alternative funding proposal which would involve the operator being expected to fund an extension to a building he does not own and/or which could result in major increases in ticket prices at the Cinema;
- 4. Rejects any plans not to proceed with the 4th Screen which would leave the Council with a major debt which could not be recovered except by raiding Council reserves and/or increasing the Council precept on local tax payers;
