

CORONA VIRUS

The Town Council are keeping up to date on the situation regarding Covid-19 and how we need to change our working practices to protect as many people as possible from infection. You will be aware that, at the time of writing, the Government has asked all those over 70 years of age, or younger with certain health conditions, to practice "social distancing" and to stay at home or away from crowds and others. HAND CLEANING

As you know there are no hand washing facilities at the Allotments. We would urge you to take hand sanitising gel to the Allotments and use this regularly and before touching taps or the padlocks and gates. Town Force will be sanitising the padlocks regularly during this time, but we need you to play your part in keeping everyone safe.







BBQs are permitted but must be disposed of off-site and fully extinguished after use.

Trees should not be allowed to grow over 8ft or 2.5m. If you have a tree on your plot taller than this please prune it as soon as it is safe to do so.

WATER

CHIN:

Water will be turned on by the end of March. Please use water carefully during dry periods. You may use a hose whilst on the allotment but MUST NOT leave it running unattended. The Rules on using hoses state:

"Hosepipes - You are not permitted to leave a hose pipe with running water unmanned"

PLEASE NOTE: Watering cans are to take priority

Hoses must be disconnected from the tap and stored on the plot or in a shed when not in use.

BONFIRES

Short, sharp bonfires are permitted for the disposal of green waste only. All other rubbish should be taken away and disposed of offsite. Bonfires should be <u>put out on leaving the</u> <u>site</u> and tenants should be mindful of smoke in a residential area.

PLEASE RESPECT YOUR NEIGHBOURS

PATHS AND EDGES Don't forget to keep paths and edges clear and cut or mown. If your plot is on the outside of the site next to the perimeter fence you should keep at least a metre away from the fence. Sheds or materials leant against the fence acts as a step for intruders, can damage the fence and means Town Force cannot strim and clear weeds from the fence line.
