184. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS AND APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The Chairman welcomed those present and went through the evacuation procedure in the event of a fire. Apologies of absence were noted from Cllr. Batley who had a prior engagement.

The grounds of the review are that the Licensing Objectives of: - The Prevention of Crime & Disorder; Public Safety have been seriously undermined.

Members expressed their disappointment at not being advised of this review at the time by Arun District Council and felt that the review was a major matter that they should have been made aware of by ADC out of courtesy. The Civic & Office Manager informed Members that an email had been sent to the Licensing Department at ADC asking if it would possible to advise the Town Council of this in future.

Following discussion, Members felt that without further details into the cause of the review it was not possible to make any comment at this time. It was **AGREED** that the Civic & Office Manager would contact the Licensing Team at ADC and report back to the Committee in due course.

AGENDA ITEM 11 - CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT ORDER FOR PROPOSED STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY AT UPPER BOGNOR ROAD TO FELPHAM WAY, BOGNOR REGIS, PO22 7BP

REPORT BY CIVIC & OFFICE MANAGER

FOR DECISION

Please find attached a copy of a draft Order proposed under the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 - Section 247, for a proposed stopping up of Highway at Upper Bognor Road to Felpham Way, Bognor Regis, PO22 7BP (OS Grid Reference: E:494387, N:099501). If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Arun District Council (ADC), under reference BR/54/16/PL (University of Chichester, Upper Bognor Road, Bognor Regis, PO21 1HR).

The term 'stopping up' means that once such an **order** is made, the highway land will cease to be a highway, road or footpath. ... The phrase 'public highway' can include roads, streets, footpaths, some public car parks, grass verges and footways. Not all roads, streets or footpaths are public highways.

Planning Application BR/54/16/PL was considered at the Planning and Licensing Committee Meeting, held on 15th March 2016, and Members agreed to submit the following representation to ADC;

OBJECTION Although Members support the development of the site they wish to object to the design due to the impact the unsympathetic and austere design will have on its setting, adjacent to both listed buildings and a Conservation Area. It is felt that the design does not comply with Policy 8a (Design Excellence) of the Neighbourhood Development Plan which states that 'Development proposals that fail to take the opportunities available for enhancing the local character and quality of the area and the way it functions will not be supported. A central part of achieving excellence in design is responding to and integrating with local surroundings landscape and context as well as the build environment through: using good quality materials that complement the existing palette of materials used within the area'. Justification of this Policy states that 'This policy aims to ensure that investments in key new buildings and spaces of our town will contribute to planning, designing and delivering attractive and lasting buildings and spaces that demonstrate a design approach relating strongly to Bognor Regis's identity'. This design also fails Policy 1 'Delivery of the Vision' of the Neighbourhood Development Plan which states that 'Major Developments should demonstrate how proposed changes will support the delivery of relevant Neighbourhood Development Plan Objectives and our vision for Bognor Regis'.

Members will be aware that Planning Application BR/56/16/PL was approved conditionally by Arun District Council and construction of the University of Chichester's Engineering & Digital Technology Park is well on its way to completion.

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY (SOUTH EAST) (NO.) ORDER 201

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of powers under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act").

- 1. The Secretary of State authorises the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the plan, in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by Arun District Council under reference BR/54/16/PL.
- 2. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then, subject to section 261(4) of the Act, those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that highway is stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.
- In this Order

"the plan"

means the plan numbered NATTRAN/SE/S247/3235, marked "Highway at Bognor Regis in the District of Arun", signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department for Transport, Deposit Document Service, F Floor, Ashdown House, St Leonards-on-Sea, Hastings, East Sussex TN37 7GA.



THE SCHEDULE

Description of highway to be stopped up

The highway to be stopped up is at Bognor Regis in the District of Arun, shown on the plan as an irregular shaped western part width of Felpham Way comprising highway verge which lies to the east of the University of Chichester, Bognor Regis Campus including a northern part width of Upper Bognor Road. It commences 177 metres north east of the north eastern corner of Barbara Smith Halls and extends southwards along Felpham Way and then westwards along Upper Bognor Road for a maximum distance of 330 metres with a maximum width of 7.5 metres.
