#### **RENTAL INCREASE FOR 2010-2011**

At the last Allotments Sub-Committee meeting, Councillors agreed to increase the rents for 2010-2011 by £1 per plot. It was felt that this was necessary to maintain the level of service provided by the Town Council. Rental reminders will be sent out in early September for payment by  $1^{st}$  October 2010.

Should you wish to give up your allotment please let me know at any time in writing, tenants do not need to wait till the end of the season. Demand for plots is exceptionally high at the moment and the waiting list for one is about 18 months.
