I am pleased to announce that at a recent meeting of the Allotments Sub-Committee it was AGREED that there will be no increase in rents for 2011/12. New rental forms for 2011/12 will be sent out in September for payment by the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2011.

## ALLOTMENT INFORMATION LEAFLET

The guidelines leaflet included with this letter has been produced by the Sub-Committee for tenants' information and includes current guidelines for both the Gravits Lane allotment sites. Please keep it safe for reference. This along with your Tenancy Agreement forms the basis of your contract with the Council. This leaflet will also be issued to new tenants when they take on an allotment. You will find an item relating to abusive behaviour to staff. Unfortunately there have been several instances of verbal abuse to Town Council staff and as a result the Allotments Sub-Committee has AGREED that the Town Council will operate **Zero Tolerance to abusive behaviour** to members of staff. Any such behaviour may result in the immediate eviction of a tenant.

There is also an item about Cultivation and the consequences of failing to do this. In recent months it has been necessary to evict a number of tenants from the allotments due to plots not being cultivated. If you are sent a warning letter please contact me as soon as possible to discuss your situation, once a Notice to Quit is issued it cannot be revoked. Along with the tenant representatives, I keep an eye on plots that are not being cultivated. Please remember to notify the office if you are unwell, are away for a length of time or have moved.

#### TENANTS ON THE RE-ESTABLISHED SITE

It has been brought to the attention of the Town Council that there have been instances of tenants leaving hose pipes left running unattended. This is unacceptable and a waste of water.

So please be vigilant with water usage.
