Registration Services

Registration offices are currently closed in Burgess Hill, East Grinstead, Littlehampton and Storrington.

Registering a death:

In light of the current guidance, we are asking that only the main person informing us of a death attends the appointment. We would also ask that anyone who is in self-isolation arranges for an alternative informant - who has not been in contact with anyone who has the virus - to collect the Medical Certificate of Death and attend the appointment.

Registering a birth:
