



- Don't spend long periods sitting or working outside in the hottest time of the day: 11am 3pm.
- 2 If you are travelling in a vehicle take a bottle of water to drink.
- Avoid strenuous activities, and limit activities to early morning/evening when its cooler.

- When inside use the coolest rooms and keep curtains/blinds closed in rooms that catch the sun.
- 5 Shut windows when its cooler inside than out and open when its hotter inside than out. Leave open at night if its safe.
- Wear loose / lightweight / lightcoloured, cotton clothing.

- **7** Take cool showers and baths.
- Splash your face with cool water or place a damp cloth on the back of your neck.
- P Drink plenty of fluids even if not thirsty.
- 10 Eat normally, try to have more cold foods that contain high water content e.g. salads and fruit.
